

GOLDEN MEADOWS DOG PARK RULES

Patrons, visitors, handlers, and users of dog park facilities voluntarily assume all risks, loss or injury for themselves or their dog(s) associated with or resulting from use of the park. It shall be unlawful for any person to violate any of the following regulations regarding the use of any city designated dog park:

- Dog Park is open from sunrise to sunset
- Only Dogs are permitted in the dog park. All other animals are strictly prohibited.
- All dogs that enter the park must be spayed or neutered,
 - have a valid license and
 - current vaccination with an accompanying tag. The tag must be securely affixed to the dog's collar at all times.
- Female dogs in heat are prohibited.
- Dogs must be on a leash anywhere throughout in Meadow Wood Sports Complex until inside the designated off-leash, fenced enclosure.
- Owners and/or handlers must watch and have control of their dog(s) and have a leash with them at all times.
- Pinch, choker chains and spiked collars must be removed from dogs prior to entering the dog park.
- Owners and/or handlers must be at least sixteen (16) years of age and remain within the park's fenced enclosure.
- Owner and/or handlers are limited to three (3) dogs per adult.
- No person under nine (9) years of age is permitted within the park's fenced enclosure(s). All other children must be supervised by an adult while in the dog park.
- Owners and/or handlers shall immediately pick up their dog's excrement and deposit it in a park trash receptacle.
- Owners and/or handlers must stop their dogs from digging and are responsible for filling any holes their dog creates.
- Aggressive, vicious, or contagious dogs are prohibited from use of the park. Dogs showing signs of aggression must be leashed and immediately removed from the park.
- Only small, bite-sized training treats are permitted. Do not share treats with other dogs.
- Glass containers, food in bowls, long lasting chews, dog toys and human food are not allowed.
- All persons shall immediately pick up any litter or trash resulting from their use of the park and deposited in a park trash receptacle.
- No bicycles, skateboards, roller blades or any motorized vehicles are allowed. Smoking is prohibited
