CHARTER REVIEW COMMITTEE OPENING

The City Council of the City of Woodland Park is accepting applications from individuals who are interested in serving as a member on the City's Charter Review Committee. The Charter Committee is made up of two councilmembers, two - four citizens, the City Manager, City Clerk and City Attorney. The council may appoint a minimum of two positions with a maximum of four positions to this Committee. These positions will expire in February of 2026. Interested applicants for this position must be a City resident for a minimum of one year prior to appointment, 18 years of age and be available to meet on a monthly basis.
